Initial Proclamation 2016 Frontiers in Oceania



JANUARY

That the Lord may inspire and sustain in our communities the capacity to welcome and accompany Christian refugees of the Middle East, who are part of the large crowd of refugees in the region.

FEBRUARY

That divisions between the various Christian denominations in South Asia may end so that the sole face of Christ may be revealed to the people.

MARCH

That the Salesian Family may be the source of solid and fruitful inspiration for Christian families everywhere.

APRIL

That our oratories and youth centres in Africa and Madagascar may really be at the forefront of mission and first evangelisation.

MAY

For the Salesian Communities in Oceania (Australia, New Zealand, Samoa, Fiji, Papua New Guinea e Solomon Islands) that the communitarian prayer of the Rosary may bring the joy of the Gospel in all our works, amongst our young people and lay collaborators.

JUNE

That all the houses of formation in the whole Congregation may draw inspiration from the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

JULY

That our schools and universities in Latin America and the Caribbean become more and more means for the spreading of the Gospel.

AUGUST

That missionary groups and the missionary voluntary service may continue to grow in every Province of the East Asia.

SEPTEMBER

That the 147th Salesian Missionary Expedition foster the missionary spirit and vocational enthusiasm throughout the Salesian Society.

OCTOBER

That all Salesians of Don Bosco may rediscover the joy and the responsibility of evangelisation.

NOVEMBER

That the South Cone Region may recognise in popular piety in the parishes where we work as the evangelising force that comes from the Holy Spirit, in order to be closer to the simple and the poor.

DECEMBER

For the consolidation and the fecundity of Project Europe in every Province of Centre - North Europe Region.
